

# McPherson College Residence Hall Internet Instructions for Registering your Xbox

All devices that connect to the Residence Hall network must register their MAC Address. To register your Xbox so that can connect to the Internet:

- 1) Load the Xbox, go all the way to the right to the system page and select it.
- 2) Now select network settings, edit settings, additional settings, and select the alternate MAC address.
- 3) You are now looking for the wired mac address, which may be displayed in the bottom left corner of the screen.
- 4) The MAC address looks something like this "0F-11-E4-4f-57-BE" or "0F11E44f57BE".
- 5) Copy the console's MAC address and then go back to your computer.
- 6) Open Internet Explorer or Firefox, copy and paste in "<http://register>" Below is a screen shot of the register webpage.

### What is ResNet?

The ResNet is the McPherson College residential hall network, and is intended for the sole use of current students, faculty and staff of McPherson College. In order to access the ResNet, you must log in with your email login ID and password, just as you would to access your email on **Bulldog** or **CS**.

Without logging in to the ResNet, you will only have access to **Bulldog**, **CS**, and **WWW** on the campus network, and will **not** have access to the Internet.
