With your health plan, you have a list of prescription drugs that are covered as part of your pharmacy benefit. This is known as your formulary.

**ResultsRx is your formulary** and was designed by Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Kansas along with the pharmacy benefit manager, Prime Therapeutics, specifically to make a greater impact on savings.

## Safe alternatives

Pharmacy experts created this list to offer safe, effective alternatives to more expensive medication. By requiring alternative and generic drugs to meet specified standards, the FDA ensures these drugs can be trusted to have the same quality and work in the same way as brand-name drugs – but at a lower cost.

This is important to know because no one wants to skimp on their health, even if it means saving money.

## Cost effective solutions

If the medication you are currently taking is a non-covered medication, you may pay the full price. By switching from an expensive brand-name medication to an alternative or generic product, you could save at least two-thirds of your out-of-pocket drug cost.

This formulary was created with our members in mind. Helping you get the right medication at the right cost is important to us. Talk to your doctor about switching to one of the alternative drugs listed within the formulary.

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## Know your coverage

With the change in formulary, your drug coverage has changed. If a drug is not on the formulary, it will not be covered by your health plan.

### Please note the following changes:

- 1 Maintenance list** | The maintenance list has been updated to the Extended Supply Network (ESN). You may now obtain up to a 90-day supply for any non-specialty drug at ESN pharmacies with a copay for each month supply. For additional savings, 90-day supplies may be obtained via Express Scripts mail order.
- 2 Formulary Driven** | The formulary determines which drugs are covered under your health plan. Reference the Results Rx formulary for a list of covered drugs.
- 3 Copay** | Your copay amount is now \$15/\$50/\$75. Specialty is 20% coinsurance up to \$250.00.
